Jubilee Year Pilgrimages

This summer, all the seminarians of the Diocese of Bridgeport joined His Excellency, Bishop Frank J. Caggiano and some benefactors of the diocese, on a pilgrimage to Rome, Orvieto and Assisi in celebration of the Jubilee Year of Hope. It was a spiritually edifying experience during which we spent time with our brothers who live and study elsewhere. One of the highlights of the trip was our visit to the Cathedral Basilica of Santa Maria Assunta in Orvieto, Italy. There, on the feast of St. James the Apostle, Sebastián Sanmiguel López received the Ministry of Acolyte during a Eucharist presided over by Bishop Caggiano, who urged us to remember that Jesus did not come to be served, but to serve, and that we can also drink from His chalice, as St. James did.

Jubliee Year Pilgrimages

To participate in the Jubilee of Youth with Pope Leo XIV, the seminarians then traveled to join their respective Neocatecumenal communities who were also on pilgrimage visiting shrines across Europe. They were present at the Pope's Mass on August 3 and for the vocational meeting with the international team of the Neocatechumenal Way in Rome the following day, where more than 10,000 men and women openly accepted the call to actively discern a religious vocation or to be sent as missionaries anywhere in the world. To conclude their pilgrimage, they celebrated the Eucharist alongside the itinerant team responsible for the Neocatechumenal communities in the United States and the American pilgrims in the plaza of the oldest Marian Shrine in Germany: the Shrine of Our Lady of Altötting.

Bishop's Visit


